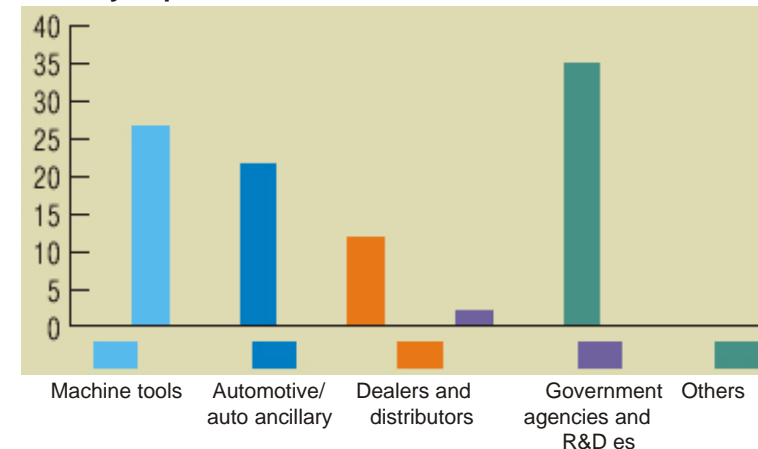

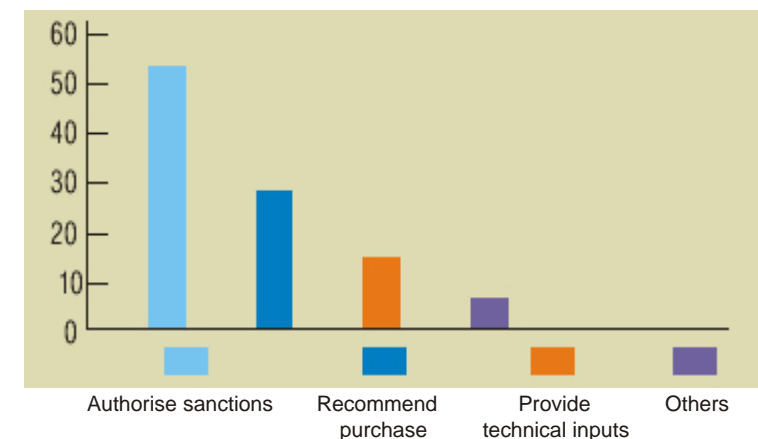

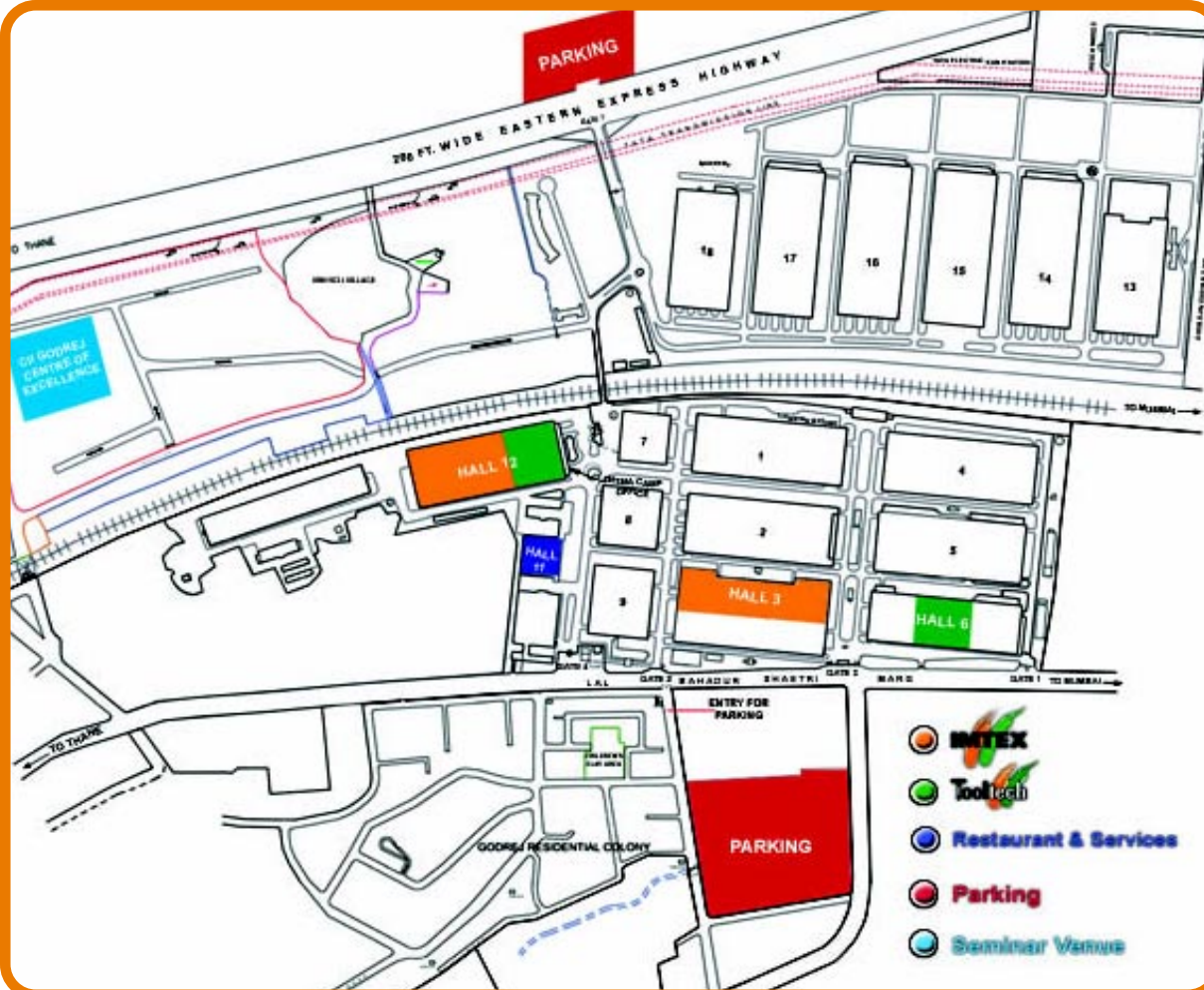
Industry Representation of Visitors
